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उपरोक्त विषयान्तर्गत सन्दर्भित पत्र के अनुक्रम में लेख है कि परिषद् द्वारा बी.एड. पाठ्यक्रम में प्रवेश प्रक्रिया ऑनलाइन आबंटन के माध्यम से किया जाता है। इस आबंटन प्रक्रिया में प्री.बी.एड. परीक्षा के प्राप्तांक के आधार पर तैयार मेरिट क्रम के आधार पर NCTE के नियमों अनुसार पात्र अभ्यर्थियों का आबंटन उनके इच्छित महाविद्यालयों में किया जाता है। इस आबंटन प्रक्रिया में अभ्यर्थी अपनी सभी जानकारी स्वयं ऑनलाइन आवेदन के माध्यम से प्रस्तुत करता है।

परिषद् द्वारा संचालित ऑनलाइन आबंटन प्रक्रिया में अभ्यर्थियों को आबंटित महाविद्यालय में अपने समस्त दस्तावेजों को जांच कराना होता है, यदि वह NCTE के नियम अनुसार पात्र है तभी उसे संबंधित महाविद्यालय प्रवेश दे सकता है। स्पष्ट है कि आपके पत्र अनुसार जो अप्रिय स्थिति उत्पन्न हो रही है उसके जिम्मेदार संबंधित महाविद्यालय है क्योंकि संभवतः वे अभ्यर्थियों के दस्तावेजों का परीक्षण सही ढंग से नहीं कर पा रहे हैं।

अतः कृपया विश्वविद्यालय के प्रादेशिक क्षेत्राधिकार तथा कोर्स/ऑफ केम्पस/स्टडी सेन्टर की जानकारी आपके विश्वविद्यालय से सम्बद्धता प्राप्त शिक्षा महाविद्यालयों को देने का कष्ट करें, ताकि भविष्य में पात्रता को लेकर कोई अप्रिय स्थिति उत्पन्न न हो।

Subject: Territorial jurisdiction & offering of programmes through off campus/
Study Centres etc by Institutions/Universities- reg.

Sir/Madam,

The University Grants Commission has from time to time been notifying its policy on territorial jurisdiction and offering of programmes through off campuses/centres/study centres by Universities/Institutions. Vide its Public Notice No. F 27-1/2012 (CPP-II), dated 27th June 2013 (copy enclosed), UGC has notified its policy on territorial jurisdiction to be followed by all Universities/Institutions including Open and Distance Learning Institutions, which is as under:

- i) a Central or State Government University can conduct courses on its own departments, its constituent colleges and/or through its affiliated colleges;
- ii) a University established or incorporated by or under a State Act shall operate only within the territorial jurisdiction allotted to it under its Act and in no case beyond the territory of the State of its location;
- iii) the private universities and deemed universities cannot affiliate any college or institution for conducting courses leading to award of its diplomas, degrees or other qualifications;
- iv) no university, whether central, state, private or deemed, can offer its programmes through franchising arrangement with private coaching institutions even for the purpose of conducting courses through distance mode;
- v) all universities shall award only such degrees as are specified by the UGC and published in the official Gazette;
- vi) the universities shall conduct their first degrees and Master's degree programmes in accordance with the regulations notified by the UGC in this regard.

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2. The UGC has also issued regulations relating to Private Universities and Deemed Universities which should be strictly followed by the concerned University. A copy of these regulations is hosted on UGC website www.ugc.ac.in.

3. However, it has come to the notice of the UGC that some Universities are offering programmes through distance mode without approval of UGC/ erstwhile DEC and several Universities/Institutions have opened their study centres in violation of the policy of UGC and erstwhile DEC on territorial jurisdiction. Some Institutions are giving misleading advertisements in newspapers and other public media that the programmes offered by these Institutions are approved by the UGC. The same is not permissible by UGC and should be immediately stopped.

4. Therefore, all Universities/Institutions are hereby requested to offer only those programmes which are approved by UGC/erstwhile DEC and follow the policy of UGC on territorial jurisdiction, study centres, and non-franchising of study centres for offering programmes through distance mode. The activities at the study centre such as admission, examination, conduct of Personal Conduct Programmes (PCPs) etc should be operated by the concerned University. Study centres cannot conduct examinations on their own nor can they award degree/diploma etc. No sub-letting of study centres should be allowed and any such centre opened by any University/Institution would be in violation of the UGC policy.

5. The UGC/erstwhile DEC has not given approval to any University for opening of ODL study centres outside India. Thus, operation of any such centre is wholly invalid and must be immediately closed. Universities/Institutions are also requested to close down any study centre opened in violation of above policy. Also any programme not recognized by the UGC/ erstwhile DEC and wherever necessary by other Apex regulatory bodies, should not be offered through distance mode.



Public Notice

on
Courses/Study Centres/Off Campuses & Territorial Jurisdiction of Universities

No. F.27-1/2012(CPP-II)

27th June, 2013

The Commission has come across many advertisements published in National Dailies offering opportunities for the award of university degrees through various franchise programmes conducted by certain private institutions. These private establishments claiming themselves as study centres or learning centres of different universities enrol students for various degree programmes and also claim to be responsible for teaching and conduct of examinations. The faculty and the infrastructure belong to these private agencies. The concerned university except providing syllabus and teaching materials, has no mechanism to monitor and maintain the academic standards of teaching being imparted at these centres. This blatant compromise with the standards of education has led to widespread criticism. The Commission has taken a serious view of these misleading advertisements appearing in various newspapers.

It is, therefore, clarified for the information of all concerned, including students and parents that:

- a) a Central or State Government University can conduct courses through its own departments, its constituent colleges and/or through its affiliated Colleges;
- b) a university established or incorporated by or under a State act shall operate only within the territorial jurisdiction allotted to it under its Act and in no case beyond the territory of the state of its location;
- c) the private universities and deemed universities cannot affiliate any college or institution for conducting courses leading to award of its diplomas, degrees or other qualifications.
- d) no University, whether central, state, private or deemed, can offer its programmes through franchising arrangement with private coaching institutions even for the purpose of conducting courses through distance mode.
- e) all universities shall award only such degrees as are specified by the UGC and published in the official gazette.
- f) the Universities shall conduct their first degree and Master's degree programmes in accordance with the regulations notified by the Commission in this regard.

In this connection, the students and the general public are also hereby informed of the following regulating provisions pertaining to different types of universities:

A. UGC Regulations on Private Universities

A private university established under a State Act shall be a unitary university. A private university may be permitted to open off campus centres, off shore campuses and study centres after five years of its coming into existence subject to the fulfillment of conditions as laid down under UGC (Establishment of & Maintenance of Standards in Private Universities) Regulations, 2003. As of now, the UGC has not granted permission to any Private University to establish off-campus/study centre.

B. UGC Regulations on Deemed Universities

A Deemed University shall operate only within its Headquarters or from those off campuses/off-shore campuses which are approved by the Government of India through notification published in the official gazette.

In case of distance education programmes, no institution deemed to be university, so declared by the Govt. of India after 26th May, 2010 [date of publication of UGC (Institutions Deemed to be Universities) Regulations, 2010] is allowed to conduct courses in the distance mode.

The institutions deemed to be universities declared before 26th May, 2010 are not allowed to conduct courses in distance mode from any of its off-campus centres/off-shore campuses approved after 26th May, 2010.

Approval for new courses and extension of approval of the courses already run by the Deemed to be Universities under distance mode would be granted by the UGC subject to the fulfillment of conditions as laid down by the UGC.

The UGC has not granted approval to any deemed to be university to establish study centres.

Any information /clarification with regard to recognition of Private Universities/Deemed Universities and the courses offered by them may be obtained from JS (CPP-I) UGC, Bahadurshah Zafar Marg, New Delhi.

C. Distance Education programmes of the Central Universities and State Govt. Universities

The Central/State Govt. Universities can conduct courses through distance mode in accordance with the provisions of their respective Act and after the approval of the UGC.

The information relating to recognized universities, list of specified degrees and all the relevant regulations/instructions/guidelines of the UGC are available on UGC website: www.ugc.ac.in.

The students are, advised not to take admission in the unapproved Study Centres, Off-Campus Centres, Franchisee Institutions, Colleges/Institutions claiming to be affiliated with Private Universities or Deemed Universities.

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कृपया संदर्भित पत्रों का अवलोकन करने का कष्ट करें। छत्तीसगढ़ राज्य में विगत कुछ वर्षों में अन्य राज्यों के निजी विश्वविद्यालयों के अध्ययन केन्द्र एवं पाठ्यक्रम, छत्तीसगढ़ शासन की बिना अनुमति के संचालित किये जाने की जानकारी प्राप्त हुई है। प्रदेश के प्रमुख समाचार पत्रों में इसे प्रमुखता से प्रकाशित किया गया है तथा छत्तीसगढ़ लोक आयोग ने इस संबंध में प्रारंभिक प्रकरण भी दर्ज किया है।

इस प्रकार अनाधिकृत रूप से संचालित पाठ्यक्रम एवं अध्ययन केन्द्रों से प्राप्त डिप्लोमा एवं डिग्रीधारी उम्मीदवार छत्तीसगढ़ राज्य में शासकीय सेवा हेतु पात्र नहीं है। इस संबंध में माननीय उच्च न्यायालय बिलासपुर के द्वारा भी प्रकरण क्रमांक डब्ल्यू.पी (एस) 3805/2010 में दिनांक 16.04.2014 को निर्णय पारित कर ऐसी संस्थाओं से प्राप्त उपाधि छत्तीसगढ़ राज्य में अमान्य कर दिया है।

छत्तीसगढ़ शासन द्वारा अन्य राज्यों के किसी भी निजी विश्वविद्यालय को अध्ययन केन्द्र संचालित करने की अनुमति नहीं दी गई है। विश्वविद्यालय अनुदान आयोग का पत्र दिनांक 07.06.2011 (प्रतिलिपि संलग्न) एवं सार्वजनिक सूचना जून 2013 में यह स्पष्ट अंकित है कि यू.जी.सी. ने किसी भी विश्वविद्यालय को अपने राज्य के परिसीमा से बाहर स्टडी सेंटर और ऑफ कैम्पस पाठ्यक्रम चलाने की अनुमति नहीं दी है।

प्रमाणित किया गया। दिनांक 27.11.2013 को भी राज्य शासन द्वारा आयुक्त, उच्च शिक्षा कार्यालय को पत्र जारी कर इसी सस्थाओं के विरुद्ध आवश्यक कार्यवाही का निर्देश देते हुए समस्त जिला पुलिस अधीक्षकों का प्रतिलिपि दी गई है।

आपसे अनुरोध है कि इस संध में तत्काल बंद कर सभीक्षा करें व यदि आपके जिले में अन्य राज्यों के शिक्षण सस्थानों के द्वारा स्टडी सेंटर/ऑफ कैंपस पाठ्यक्रम आदि संचालित किए जा रहे हैं, तो उनके विरुद्ध नियमानुसार कड़ी कार्यवाही किया जाना सुनिश्चित करें तथा उक्त संस्थाओं के छात्रों के हित में तत्काल बंद कराने का कष्ट करें। छ.ग.राज्य में, शासन द्वारा अधिनियमित विश्वविद्यालयों की सूची संलग्न है। (परिशिष्ट-अ)

पत्र के साथ कुछ निजी विश्वविद्यालयों की सूची भी संलग्न है (परिशिष्ट-ब) जिनके द्वारा अनाधिकृत रूप से छत्तीसगढ़ राज्य में अध्ययन केन्द्र/आफ कैंपस सेंटर संचालित करने की जानकारी समाचार पत्रों से ज्ञात हुआ है। इन संस्थाओं के विरुद्ध तत्काल कड़ी वैधानिक कार्यवाही किया जाना आवश्यक होगा।

कृपया उपरोक्त कार्यवाही 30 जून, 2014 तक आवश्यक रूप से पूर्ण कर लेवें, ताकि नये शैक्षणिक सत्र प्रारंभ होने से पूर्व इन अवैधानिक संस्थाओं के प्रति छात्रों को सचेत किया जा सके। कृपया इस संबंध में की गयी कार्यवाही से अवगत कराने का कष्ट करें एवं किसी प्रकार की कठिनाई/मार्गदर्शन की आवश्यकता हो तो संचालनालय उच्च शिक्षा के अपर संचालक श्री आर.बी.सुब्रहमन्यन (मोबाईल नम्बर 9406054294) से संपर्क किया जा सकता है।

Status with regard to Distance Learning Programmes and Territorial Jurisdiction of State Private Universities

A. UGC Regulation on Distance Education

The UGC vide its Regulations dated 25.11.1985 laid down the minimum standards of Instructions of the grant of the first degree through non-formal/ distance education. With regard to Private Universities, the UGC laid down the UGC (Establishment of and maintenance of standards in Private Universities) Regulations 2003, which was notified in the Gazette on 12.12.2003. These Regulations, inter-alia, laid down that a Private University established under State Act shall operate ordinarily within the boundary of State concerned. However, after the development of main campus, in exceptional circumstances, the University may be permitted (by the UGC) to open off campus centres, off-shore campus and study centres after 5 years of its coming into existence, subject to certain conditions indicated therein.

B. Decision of Supreme Court and its Implications

2. In the landmark Judgement of Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of Prof. Yashpal & Anr. Versus State of Chattisgarh & others (2005), the Apex Court specifically considered the issue of extra territorial operation of State enactment in the form of establishment of Off campus centres, Off-shore campus and study centres and ultimately in the light of the constitutional mandate as contained in Article 245(1) of the Constitution, laid that "Parliament alone is competent making laws in the whole or any part of the Territory of India and the legislative of State making laws for the whole or any part of State".

3. The Allahabad High Court in its Judgement and Order dated 25.07.2005, after considering the matter in the light of the provisions of the UGC Act, 1956 and the Judgement of the Apex Court in the Prof. Yashpal case held that Rohilkhand University could not establish Study Centres in the State beyond its territorial jurisdiction and the setting up of Study Centres beyond the territorial jurisdiction of the State of Uttar Pradesh cannot also be justified even if the State Act is amended, in view of the decision of the Supreme Court in the case of Prof. Yashpal. Several other Courts, including the Division Bench of Madras High Court, the Madhya Pradesh High Court etc. have also dealt with this matter and gone in accordance with the ratio in the Yashpal case.

4. The effect and meaning of the judgement of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the Yashpal case is that each University in the country must have its own territorial jurisdiction and the State University established under the State Act cannot go beyond the territorial jurisdiction of the State concerned to grant affiliation to any institution.

5. The UGC vide its letter dated 16.04.2009 informed all the State Governments to take suitable steps for amending the existing state Acts so as to bring the same in conformity with the observations made by that Apex Court in the Yashpal case, and with the request to the State Governments to stop all the State/ State Private Universities from operating beyond the Territorial jurisdiction of the State in any manner, either in the form of Off Campus/Study Centre/affiliated College and Centres operating through franchises. The UGC vide its letter dated 28.04.2009 informed Vice-Chancellors of all Private Universities to ensure that no off campus centre is opened outside the territorial jurisdiction of the State, in case any such Off campus centre has been started, the same should be immediately closed and further that any off campus centre within the State shall be opened only in accordance with the UGC Regulations of 2003 and with prior approval of the UGC. These were also reiterated to the Vice-Chancellors of all the State Universities vide letter of UGC dated 15.06.2009.

C. Policy of Distance Education Council (DEC)

6. The Distance Education Council (DEC) which has been regulating programmes in Distance Education in Higher Education accords recognition to the Universities/ Institutions but not to any Learning/Study Centres of such Universities/Institutions for offering programmes through distance mode. Thus, the DEC does not accord any approval to Study Centres. In the Joint Committee meeting of the DEC held on 17.08.2009, it was decided that the UGC Notifications will prevail over all previous Notifications and circulars. Accordingly, the State Universities (both Private and Government funded) can offer programmes only within the State and Deemed Universities from the Headquarters and in no case outside the State. The Territorial jurisdiction of the institutions other than Universities shall be the Headquarters and in no case outside the State concerned. The DEC vide its Notification dated 01.11.2012 notified its policy on Territorial jurisdiction to be followed by Open and Distance Learning Institutions which is as under:-

- In case of Central Universities, the Territorial Jurisdiction will be as per their Acts and Statutes for offering programmes through distance mode.
- In case of State Universities (both Govt. funded and private), the Territorial Jurisdiction will be as per their Acts and Statutes but not beyond the boundaries of their respective States.
- In case of Deemed to be Universities, the Territorial Jurisdiction will be as per the notification of Govt. of India to accord them this status until a policy decision is taken by the UGC.

- The Territorial Jurisdiction in case of Private Institutions (other than Universities) will be headquarters. In case any such Institution desires to offer programmes beyond its headquarters then it should establish its new institutions as per norms.
- The study centres are simply facilitators in programme delivery. No University/ Institution will be allowed to franchise the Study centres; the Universities/Institutions will have to operate the study centre themselves.

D. Transfer of regulatory functions of Distance Learning from DEC to UGC

7. In accordance with the directions of the Central Government contained in its Order dated 29.12.2012, the responsibility of undertaking the regulatory functions of the Distance Education has been transferred from DEC to UGC. The UGC has vide its Notification dated 17.06.2013 decided that the UGC shall be formulating its Regulations with regard to the programmes in Distance Learning, and further that till such time the said Regulations are brought into force, the extant Guidelines of the DEC on the minimum requirements for recognition of ODL Institutions shall continue.

8. Vide its Public Notice dated 27.06.2013, the UGC has laid down the guiding principles with regard to the Territorial Jurisdiction of Universities on courses/ Study Centres/off campus centres. It has been, inter-alia, clarified in the said Public Notice that a University established or incorporated by or under a State Act shall operate only within the Territorial jurisdiction allotted to it under its Act and in no case beyond the Territorial Jurisdiction of the State of its location. Further, the Private State Universities and Deemed Universities cannot affiliate any college or institution for conducting courses leading to award of its diplomas/degrees or other qualifications.

9. The regulatory functions of Distance Education are now being administered and handled by the UGC. For the purpose of dealing with the pending applications, an Expert Committee has been constituted under Prof. Mohd. Miyan, Vice-Chancellor, Maulana Azad National Urdu University, Hyderabad. This Committee has held three meetings in June-July, 2013 and given its recommendations in respect of 205 pending applications. The recommendations have been considered by the UGC and a decision has been taken in the Commission in its last meeting held on 31.07.2013 in respect of these cases. The Distance Education Bureau of the UGC has already conveyed the decision of the Commission to 83 Institutions/ Universities while action is being taken in respect of remaining Universities/ Institutions.
