Respected Sir/Madam,

The efforts of your entire team in deputing teachers for participation in the training programmes and responses to CCRT's other requests regarding scholarships, fellowships were really overwhelming.

You are kindly aware the Centre for Cultural Resources and Training (CCRT) is one of the premier institutions in the country working in the field of "Linking Education with Culture". Its main objective is to organize a variety of training programmes for in-service teachers from Primary to Senior Secondary level, teacher educators (including DIET Lecturers) and administrators in order to emphasize the need of integrating Cultural Inputs in Pedagogy.

The participating teachers/teacher educators are made aware of incorporating a cultural component in pre-service and in-service training by using methodologies prepared by the CCRT for cultural orientation and preparation of teaching-learning material under the mandated objectives allotted to CCRT.

The Ministry of Culture, Government of India has entrusted the responsibility to CCRT of organizing training programmes for Teachers/Teacher Educators on Linking Education with Culture, apart from awarding national scholarships, fellowships, organizing short courses on art management, data collection on National Mission on Cultural Mapping and Roadmap dissemination of cultural traditions.

In order to achieve its objectives, the CCRT organizes the following training programmes for in-service teachers/teacher educators to help them achieve integrated approach to education and provide methodologies for cultural inputs in the curriculum:

- 1. Orientation Course for
  - In-service Teachers and
  - Teacher Educators
- 2. Thematic Workshops on:
  - Role of Puppetry in Education
  - Role of Schools in Conservation of the Natural and Cultural Heritage
  - Integrating Craft Skills in School Education and
  - Our Cultural Diversity

The CCRT has planned to organize the training programmes for the year 2018-19 as per the details given in Annex-I.

Annex-II gives information about the objectives, content and <u>eligibility criteria</u> for deputation of teachers for Training Programmes from in-service school teachers of Government and Government-aided schools and teacher educators working in Teacher Training Institutions/B.Ed Colleges and DIETs of your State/UT.

I would therefore, request you to get deputed 10 (Ten) in-service school teachers of Government and Government aided schools of your State/UT for Orientation Courses and Thematic Workshops in each of these Training Programmes as per eligibility criterion. I hope while deputing teachers, preference will be given to female teachers as well as teachers belonging to Schedule Castes/Schedule Tribes/Other Backward Classes. It may kindly be noted that only those teachers who are working on regular basis are eligible to participate in the training programmes of the CCRT. The in-service teachers those who have attended the same CCRT's training programmes earlier should neither be deputed nor would be eligible to participate.

Keeping in view to have proper logistical arrangements at the venue(s), it may kindly be instructed that the information of deputed teachers' confirmed participation must be communicated to the CCRT on or before stipulated date as mentioned in each of our forthcoming letters sent to SCERT/State Education Departments/Concerned Officials in regular intervals. To strengthen and streamlining the planning and help for making logistical arrangements in a planned manner that in case no information with regard to the confirmed participation of teachers from the competent authorities is received at CCRT, such teachers, even if reporting at the venue(s) will neither be registered in the training programme nor be paid TA by CCRT.

As the CCRT trained teachers are eligible after the gap of two years to attend further/other training programmes viz Workshop on Aesthetic Photography /District Resource Persons, Refresher Courses, thematic workshops, therefore, the selection of the CCRT trained teachers in these training programmes done by CCRT, will be informed to the Education Department(s) whenever such need arises.

The details regarding boarding & lodging arrangements and payment of TA to the participants to be made by the CCRT are placed at Annex-III.

In case of any postponement or cancellation of the programme due to unavoidable circumstances, your office/Department will be informed well in advance.

The expenditure on Training, Boarding and Lodging and Travelling Allowance to the participants will be borne by the CCRT. There is no financial liability either on the State Education Department or on the concerned institution.

CCRT thankfully acknowledges continued support and co-operation of your department which is a great source of encouragement for organizing the training programmes by the CCRT.

While availing the opportunity of writing this to you, may I also extend invitation to you to visit CCRT office, whenever you or your representative visit Delhi. The CCRT also seeks to organize various educational activities with the collaboration of your department. We expect that State Education Department will also suggest collaborative activities.

I am looking forward to receiving your unstinting support in this regard.

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The Orientation Course is organised for Middle/Secondary/Senior Secondary School teachers and Teacher Educators from all parts of the country throughout the year. It is approximately of three weeks duration and consists of a variety of programmes such as lectures, lecture - demonstrations, practical classes on handicrafts and other academic areas of the training programme and educational tours to places of natural and cultural interest. The training programme introduces the participants to the rich fabric of our artistic and cultural heritage. It is designed to give the participants an idea of the variety of creative expressions in India and how the school children can be exposed to the beauty in nature and art. Members of the community and specially the younger generation need to understand the cultural heritage, the variety of geo-physical features and racial, religious, linguistic groups that have contributed to the aesthetic quality and richness of our culture. It is this awareness that fosters love for all mankind and helps in producing better citizens.

# The Orientation Course has the following objectives:

- To create an awareness about Indian culture, its continuity and diversity.
- ➤ To develop methodologies for incorporating cultural components in classroom teaching to make teaching learning a total experience.
- > To provide an opportunity to interact with scholars, artists, educationists for positive attitudinal changes towards innovative teaching.
- > To provide skills and training in creative expressions by integrating arts in education.
- To provide an opportunity to participants teaching various disciplines (subjects) in different parts of the country to work together for the integrated approach to education.

### **The Course Content:**

The framework of the Course consists of:

- theoretical study of art and culture;
- practical training in arts & crafts;
- preparation of lesson plans, Project on methodologies of Linking Education with Culture;
- educational tours to historical monuments, museums and nature parks;
- evaluation through discussions, and studies on culture and education;
- other educational activities.

Illustrated lectures and lecture demonstrations on aspects of Philosophy, Aesthetics, Architecture, Sculpture, Painting, Literature, Music, Dance, Theatre, Folk and Traditional Arts, Handicrafts, etc. are arranged. These aim at giving an orientation and background to the participants with regard to the various facets of India's rich artistic and cultural heritage in a concrete and tangible form. The lectures in each subject give brief historical background alongwith some essential definitions and details of techniques pertaining to the art forms. The major stress, however, is on how to create interest and appreciation of Indian Culture in the minds of the young generation. All these lectures are profusely illustrated and in subjects like music and dance etc. the lectures are supplemented with live demonstrations and recitals. The lectures are delivered by renowned scholars/experts/artists of their respective fields.

Apart from these lectures, practical classes in wheel thrown pottery, book binding, macrame, tie & dye, and other traditional handicrafts are also arranged and each teacher participant is expected to learn at least three to four crafts in depth. Each teacher trainee spends about a week, learning skills and techniques of these crafts which can be easily taught in the schools. The teachers are offered training in those crafts which are suitable for Indian schools in terms of cost, availability of materials and productive value.

In addition, songs in Indian languages are taught during the course. In these sessions an attempt is made to sensitize the teachers to the inherent beauty in all the languages and the richness and variety in musical expressions. The teachers are also introduced to movement and mime through body exercises and traditional *mudras* and gestures used in Indian dance forms. These activities help the trainees/trainee teachers to enhance their communication skills and relate their classroom teaching to poetry, music and movement, to create an environment for discovering the inner potential and talents of the children/students. The participants prepare educational aids and other teaching material on the use of art for education. The Orientation Course also aims at training teachers to devise innovative methodologies for making classroom teaching interesting and to integrate knowledge of arts & crafts with curriculum.

Towards the end of the training, the participants finalize lesson plans and sometimes work with local school students for obtaining evaluation and feed-back.

A unique feature of the Training Programme is that teachers teaching different disciplines coming from different parts of the country, speaking a variety of languages stay together and learn about the multifaceted aspects of life and culture of India. In addition to creating an awareness and interest in our heritage, it helps them integrate this knowledge with teaching learning practices.

The deputed teachers/teacher educators should have a good academic record and are drawn largely from the disciplines of social sciences and language teaching. Teachers from other disciplines may also be selected if they are interested in this programme. A good command over the English language is necessary as the medium of instructions during the training will be in English. This is for the benefit of teachers participating from all parts of the country.

To enable the teacher to carry out the work effectively, each school from where the teacher is trained, is provided with the CCRT's <u>Cultural Software</u> including cultural packages, subject to availability. The use of materials would entail extra work for the teacher, hence the <u>Kit</u> is supplied to selected schools, subject to the interest shown by the teacher in the course, his/her attendance and active participation in the programme & his/her performance in the evaluations during the training. The <u>Cultural Software</u> cannot be claimed as a matter of right by the institution which the teacher represents in the training programme.

**Few guidelines for recommending the names of teachers to be sent on deputation:** (Final selection rests with the CCRT)

- Teachers should be upto 52 years of age at the time of registration (It is mandatory to provide proof of date of birth at the time of registration)
- Teachers belonging to various disciplines e.g. Language, History, Geography, Civics, Mathematics, Science (s), Fine Arts, Commerce, Economics, Music, etc. should be recommended for the course. The name of the teacher belonging to Yoga, Physical Education and SUPW disciplines <u>must not be recommended for training</u> Only one teacher should be recommended from one school at a time for the Orientation Course.
- Teachers teaching in classes 6<sup>th</sup>/7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup>/9<sup>th</sup>/10<sup>th</sup>/11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> only should be recommended for deputation. Primary School teachers and Headmasters/Principals, should not be recommended for participation in Orientation Courses.

- The teachers who already have participated in the Orientation Course should not be deputed/recommended again.
- Preference may be given to female teachers for recommending/deputing for participation in the Orientation Course.
- Teachers on <u>contract/probation should not</u> be deputed as only regular teachers are eligible for Orientation Course.
- Teachers having a minimum of 02 years teaching experience should be deputed.

## Workshop on "ROLE OF PUPPETRY IN EDUCATION"

Puppetry has played an important role in disseminating knowledge in most parts of the world. Puppetry imbibes elements of all art forms such as literature, painting, sculpture, music, dance, drama, and enables students to develop their creative abilities. Puppetry has been used traditionally in India as a popular and an inexpensive medium to transmit knowledge about Indian myths and legends.

Since Puppetry is a dynamic art form that appeals to all age groups, this medium of communication has been selected to serve as an aid for imparting education in schools. The CCRT provides a comprehensive and an integrated training in the preparation, manipulation and production of such puppet programmes which may be used in a variety of formal and non-formal teaching situations. The Workshop on "Role of Puppetry in Education" is organized for the in-service primary school teachers from all parts of the country throughout the year. It is approximately of 15-16 days duration.

# **Objectives:**

- to introduce Puppetry as an aid to education,
- to teach preparation and manipulation of glove, shadow, rod, string and other puppets, out of low cost material & easy to use in classroom situation,
- to prepare educational scripts and programmes for teaching curriculum subjects through puppetry and to study the impact of training for evaluation,
- to enable teachers to acquire knowledge about traditional puppet theatre forms of India and to provide them with an opportunity to interact with traditional puppeteers,
- to encourage teachers to improvise inexpensive teaching aids and to make creative activities for students an integral part of classroom teaching.

To achieve the above mentioned aims, the training program is divided into four parts:

- : Preparation of various types of puppets and their manipulation techniques,
- : Preparation of educational scripts,
- : Practical training in allied arts like story-telling, role play, voice modulation/speech, mime and movement, music and its improvisation,
- : Production and presentation of educational programmes for school students with practical experience through interactive session.

Introductory lecture sessions on "Concept of Puppets and Script Writing" are very important for the success of the Workshop. A good educational message is the core of the puppet play. Great emphasis is given to the writing of the script for puppet plays. Suitable themes for puppet plays are suggested according to the target audience and few good stories are selected after the discussion sessions on stories developed by the participants.

Traditional artists from different parts of the country are invited from time to time to acquaint the teachers with regional traditional forms of puppetry. Lecture-demonstrations on Traditional Puppet Theatre of India are organized for the participants to introduce the different styles of puppet theatre in the country. Participants are taught to make and manipulate simple paper puppets like finger puppets, masks and paper rod puppets.

The participants are informed that the Workshop aims at production of simple puppets out of easily available and waste materials to convey educational concepts and create awareness of social issues in the classroom.

Manipulation of all these puppets is taught after each practical session. Teachers learn to produce educational puppet programmes with the help of these different kinds of puppets.

Educational visits to places of historical importance and museums are organized.

Sessions on folk music/music for theatre are also organized.

Resource material on puppetry using modern technology developed by the Centre will be used from time to time.

A few CCRT Educational Publications with Audio-CD's and a 'Puppetry Kit' are gifted to the school through the participating teacher after successful completion of the said Workshop.



The following points may please be noted while deputing the teachers for the Workshop on "Role of Puppetry in Education"

- 1. The Workshop is for in-service Govt./Govt. aided school teachers teaching classes I to V **should be upto 52 years of age** (It is essential to give proof of Date of Birth at the time of Registration).
- 2. Headmaster/Headmistress/ Principals of school should not be deputed for participation in the Workshop
- 3. Those teachers who have already attended a course on "Puppetry in Education"/Workshop on "Role of Puppetry in Education" organized by the CCRT as per your record should not be deputed again for the same Workshop.
- 4. No Contractual or Temporary Teachers like Shiksha-Karmi, Shiksha-Bandhu, Shiksha-Mitra, Education Friend, Teacher Facilitator, Sanvidha Shikshak, etc. should be deputed.
- 5. The lectures will be delivered in English for the benefit of the teachers participating from all parts of the country. Therefore, an understanding and working knowledge of English is essential.
- 6. As the working hours will be long and the workshop will be held in a camp atmosphere, teachers should be in good health.
- 7. The deputed teachers may be asked not to bring any escort/family member with them under any circumstance.
- 8. Only one teacher should be deputed for participation from one school at a time in a Workshop.
- 9. Your deputation order will be treated as a final order and the CCRT will not issue any selection letter to individuals.
- 10. For correspondence with the CCRT our letter reference number and date must be quoted.

For registration on the first day of the Workshop and for payment of TA/DA on the last day of the Workshop, the deputed teachers must bring the following certificates on separate sheets of paper:-

- i) Date of Birth Certificate
- ii) Relieving Certificate from the School
- iii) Basic Pay Certificate
- iv) Two passport size photographs
- v) Tickets/Ticket Nos. (Original of the onward journey performed and photocopy of the return journey). To and fro tickets of the entitled class and by shortest route should be purchased for the journey.

As this will be a good opportunity for deputed teachers from different States/UTs to stay together, interact with each other and share a common platform, they should bring some of the traditional puppets of their region if possible, which will be returned to them after the Workshop.

The participating teachers will also be given an opportunity to present their regional cultural programme. Hence the deputed teachers may also be requested to bring costumes, repertoire of folk songs, dances and other important items of cultural value which they would like to share with their colleagues from other States/UT's during the Workshop.

Since it is difficult to get the confirmed return reservation in a short time, we would like to suggest that the deputed teachers make their "return reservation" from their headquarters beforehand.

### **BRIEF NOTE**

### Workshop on "INTEGRATING CRAFT SKILLS IN SCHOOL EDUCATION"

Education at all stages has been regarded as a powerful instrument for social transformation. The major task of education in India today is to usher in a democratic, socialistic, secular society which removes prejudices among people. ### **Traveling Allowance:**

- 1. The teacher participants of CCRT Training Programmes are entitled to travel by AC 3-tier/ AC Chair Car/ Sleeper class of all the trains, as the case may be, from their nearest railway station head to the venue of the programme, by the shortest route. Submission of the Xerox of the ticket is **mandatory**.
- 2. Those who travel by bus from outstation are entitled to claim deluxe bus fare subject to the production of bus ticket failing which the fare will be restricted to ordinary bus fare. Teachers are required not to travel by AC buses.
- 3. For local road journey i.e. from school to Railway Station/ Bus Stand, the reimbursement will be made as per actual distance or upto 8 Km whichever is less @ Rs. 12/- per km.
- 4. For local road journey from the nearest Railway Station/ Bus Stand to the venue of the training programme, the teachers will be paid Auto/ Bus fare as per CCRT rule.

Please note that the Rail/Bus fare will be reimbursed by the CCRT if original/photocopies of the tickets are attached to the T.A. Bills for inward as well as outward journey failing which the claim will be restricted to rail fare by sleeper class. There is no provision for Air Fare/Tatkal/Flexi Fare and even if the teacher travel by any of these mode, their claim will be restricted to rail fare as per their entitlement i.e. AC-3tier/AC Chair Car/Sleeper Class as the case may be on production of original/photocopies of the journey tickets.

The teacher participants from Andaman & Nicobar Group of Islands and Lakshadweep Group of Islands are entitled to travel between the mainland and their respective institution by 'Bunk Class' of ships operated by the Shipping Corporation of India Limited/MV Swarajdweep/Nancowry/Nicobar/Campbell Bay/MV Harshavardhana. However, for travel by MV Akbar, they are entitled to travel by AC Dormitory also in addition to Bunk Class.

For the to & fro journey from the mainland to the venue of the training programmes, their travelling allowance entitlements will be governed by the same CCRT norms as per details given above.

The teacher participants will be paid Allowances for attending the training programmes as per the CCRT's norms.

The CCRT will be providing free lodging and boarding facilities mandatorily to all the participants.

All allowances will be transferred to the authorized bank account through RTGS/NEFT/ECS, as
per details provided by the participants, on successful completion of the training programme,
hence correct account details should be provided to the CCRT. The teacher participants are
expected to fill up the correct account details in the prescribed format and must enclose a copy of
cancelled cheque leaf also.
